Cleaning & Maintenance

Operating Instructions

1. Select an Appropriate Location:

Determine the area where you need to restrict access. Ensure that the magnetic mount can securely attach to a metal surface nearby.

2. Position the Barrier:


Locate a suitable metal surface (e.g., a service truck, the equipment being serviced, a door frame, a metal post, or a steel column) near the area you want to control. The magnetic base should have a strong connection to this surface.

3. Attach the Magnetic Mount:


Place the magnetic mount on the selected metal surface and ensure it's securely attached. Make sure the surface is clean and free from debris, as this can affect the strength of the magnetic connection.

4. Extend the Retractable Belt:

Locate the retractable belt housing at the top of the barrier pole. To lock the belt, turn the dial located at the base of the belt connection clockwise 180 degrees. To release the belt, turn the dial located at the base of the belt connection clockwise an additional 180 degrees.

5. Pull Out the Belt:

Gently pull out the retractable belt to the desired length to create the barrier. Be cautious not to pull it out too quickly or forcefully, as this can cause it to become tangled or damaged.

6. Secure the Belt:

Once you've extended the belt to the desired length, find another suitable anchor point for attaching the belt's end.

7. Attach the Belt End:

Attach the end of the belt onto the anchor point securely. Ensure that the belt is taut and properly aligned to create a clear barrier.

8. Adjust as Needed:

If you need to change the length or position of the barrier, simply unlock the belt, make the necessary adjustments, and re-lock it.

9. Monitor and Maintain:

Periodically check the barrier to ensure it remains secure and in good working condition. Clean the belt if it becomes dirty or stained.

10. Remove the Barrier:

To remove the barrier, unlock the belt, detach it from the anchor point, and retract it back into the housing by gently guiding it in. Ensure the magnetic mount is properly detached from the metal surface.

By following these steps, you can effectively use a magnetic-mounted retractable belt barrier to create a safer and more restricted work-site.
